

## Tree dedication scheme – Terms and Conditions

All applications under the tree dedication scheme should be made by our online application form [www.warwickshirewildlifetrust.org.uk/dedicate-tree](http://www.warwickshirewildlifetrust.org.uk/dedicate-tree)

A suggested donation of £25 per tree.

Your kind donation per tree covers the costs for the tree, stakes, biodegradable tree guards, planning and planting labour costs, together with a donation towards the upkeep of Warwickshire Wildlife Trust nature reserves.

Trees will be chosen by Warwickshire Wildlife Trust to fit into the woodland management plan of the nature reserve, most of the trees we plant will be native broadleaf species.

You will not be allocated a specific tree, but we will update you on where trees have been planted on your chosen nature reserve.

Warwickshire Wildlife Trust will plant your tree on your chosen reserve, unless reasons such as over crowding or other wildlife requirements mean that the tree cannot be planted in that location. Should this situation occur, the Trust will plant the tree where it is most needed and will inform you of the change of location.

Warwickshire Wildlife Trust will maintain the trees in line with our current woodland management plan. This means the tree may be subject to thinning, coppicing or ultimately removal, if necessary, throughout the years, but these actions will only be taken if deemed necessary by the Trust and to improve the site for wildlife in the future. Warwickshire Wildlife Trust accepts no responsibility if dedication trees are damaged, vandalised or stolen.

Warwickshire Wildlife Trust will usually only plant trees between the months of November to March, therefore your tree may not be planted at time of purchase.

Warwickshire Wildlife Trust ask that if you are visiting a dedication area, you do not mark trees or leave anything behind, such as flowers, wreaths, or any other dedications, any dedications left behind will be removed to maintain the integrity of the site.

Warwickshire Wildlife Trust currently offer four locations for dedication tree planting. These are:

- Bubbenhall Wood
- Snitterfield Bushes
- Wappenbury Wood
- Swift Valley
- Oakley Wood
- Bishops Hill
- Harbury Spoilbank

Locations for dedication planting will change depending on the Trust's requirements and woodland management plans.

Within 14 days of purchase, you will receive:

- A personalised letter
- A digital certificate
- A map of the dedication area at your chosen reserve
